# WALKING Together Through this Pandemic

#### 'Unprecedented' is wellused but not entirely spent on describing this pandemic.

Have you seen anything like it in your lifetime? Of course, someone like my late grandmother would have well understood the situation. She died in 2000 at the ripe old age of 100 years and six months.

As children, she recalled to us the memory of her mother crying at the kitchen table as the



Belfast Telegraph landed on their doorstep, the weight of granite and pallbearing in black ink the news of the Titanic's sinking. She was only 12. She married a veteran of The Somme, my grandfather, and throughout our young years regaled us with stories of war in the trenches of WWI and the Belfast blitz of WW2; near where she lived anti-aircraft guns crackled and roared at the whirling klaxon's call. But she never mentioned Spanish Flu. Similar to today's pandemic, it wasn't as severe in Ireland as it was in London and other parts of the world.

Like me, you have nobody to ask, 'What was it like and how did everyone get through it?'

I think that's what makes this whole experience extra-difficult.

As a church community, we have found hope in spite of this gap in local knowledge and wisdom. A confidence really, from our experience of God. It's startling for a person to discover the experiences of God described in the Bible, are your experiences of God today! That really sums up personal stories of Christians the world over.

The best advice I can give you as the world endures this pandemic for a few extra months is to ask God to walk with you. Imagine Jesus replying to your simple request! What a difference He could make. God's desire is to know you and be part of your life. Jesus says, "Ask and it will be given to you, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened to you (Matthew 7.7)."
