#### Prayer Points Sunday 27th March 2022

Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

Romans 12:12

- Almighty God, we thank you for your care and loving kindness and for the hope that we
  have through Jesus. We pray particularly this week for the residents of Rathmore Avenue,
  Rathmore Gardens and Rathmore Park, that hearts would open to you and more people
  come to know your care, love and hope for them.
- Lord, many in our congregation have or have had Covid in recent months, or have other challenging health, family or personal concerns. We pray that they would find in you, not only strength and courage, but deep peace and lasting hope. Keep us alert to each other's needs, so that we might be available to offer a helping hand or listening ear. Remind us that we are never alone for we journey together with you.
- God of hope, we continue to pray for peace in war-torn Ukraine and for the huge numbers
  of bereaved, wounded, distressed and displaced people. Keep us faithful in prayer as
  millions will need support for a long time. Guide James, Moyna, John and the session as they
  consider how Lowe can help in this crisis. Bless the efforts of Andor in Oderheiu, Romania,
  as he drives a 1,000 kilogram load of rice, oil, sugar and flour to border villages, where the
  schools and churches are full of refugees. We pray for his safety on the 4-hour journey each
  way with a trailer, much of it on poor country roads.
- Our Father in heaven, bless Bayarmaa, Zorigoo, Nandin and Orgil Erdenebilig in the Netherlands. We thank you that you have brought them to Europe, after years of prayer and effort, and for the master's course where Bayarmaa is delighted to be enriching her knowledge of God, the Bible and ministry. Help her as she divides her time between quite intense classes for her degree, challenging assignments, a 1.5 hour each way commute 4 days a week, and family needs. We thank you that Zorigoo currently has flexible paid employment helping to renovate a house. We pray for an urgent resolution to on-going registration problems with the immigration office and City Hall so that Zorigoo's visa will not be cancelled. We lift up Nandin and Orgil to you as they learn Dutch so they can benefit fully from school and develop vital friendships.
