

I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth. (Psalm 121:1-2)

- Our loving Heavenly Father, many in our society are worried, distressed or simply weary with war news and Covid's impact on life. May your people abide in you, reflecting your love and peace to their neighbours and work colleagues. We pray particularly this week for the residents of Chippendale Court, Chippendale Gardens, De Beere Court, Finaghy Road South, Hollymount Court, Redhill Manor and Trinity Court that hearts would open to you and more people come to know the love and peace you offer.
- God of peace and justice, we continue to pray for the people of Ukraine as the weather has turned bitterly cold, especially at night. We pray for an and end to hostilities and for safe shelter, food, water and warmth for the 42 million still in Ukraine. We thank you for the huge effort in Europe to transport, feed and find accommodation for the over 2 million refugees. In your mercy, bless Zsuzsi and Andor in Odorheiu, Romania, just 100 miles south of the Ukrainian border. Even as they describe themselves 'distressed but trusting' may they know your peace and guidance whilst pastoring their large and anxious congregation. Help them work with their congregation which has been asked to provide accommodation and support for 20 refugees.
- In your wisdom, Lord, guide James, Moyna and the session as they seek your will for the future at Lowe. Give them insight as they consider how to respond to the recent survey on church service times. We thank you for their recent and encouraging conference facilitated by Alan McWilliam from The Cairn. In the power of your Holy Spirit, renew and enthuse us to be more effective in reaching others with the gospel.
- Lord of all the nations, we ask your blessing on the Madlener family. Prosper Werner's work with London City Mission and as he leads a church cell group week by week. Remember Cecelia, a full-time nurse and part-time volunteer speaker for the Mercy ships enabling medical professionals to bring help to disadvantaged countries. We ask that Joshua, in this his GCSE year, can be cured of the bad stomach pains he has had in recent weeks. We pray with Michelle, now about half way through her year on Operation Mobilisation's ship Logos Hope, for safety and wisdom in the Deck department, and for good ministry opportunities in the upcoming port visits to Takoradi, Ghana and Monrovia, Liberia. May the family reunion in Africa over Easter be a wonderful and happy occasion.
